Feedback Analysis 2018-19

Effectiveness of Teaching Learning Process, administration, library, Sports facilities, etc. was evaluated using feedback obtained from different stakeholders. Online structured feedback is collected from Students, teachers and alumni through college website. The feedback is based on five point scale. After analyzing the feedback, necessary actions are taken. It serves as an important source of information for development and enhancement of the institution.

About curriculum

The curriculum is well structured, systematic and reflecting predefined outcomes. 97% students and 70 % teachers are agreeing with the same, while 99 % alumni gave excellent / very good rating in relation to their current job / occupation and the courses that they have learnt in the college. Enough teaching materials and teaching aids to teach curriculum is available; have opined by 87% students, alumni and teachers are satisfied with that. More than 97% students are satisfied with the fact that adequate knowledge was gained during course of study.

More than 97% students and 64 % teachers are satisfied that the designed curriculum helps to obtain employment and creates an interest to pursue post graduation/Research. The teachers are advised to cater professional knowledge in curriculum so that it will be helpful in job seeking process.

About library

The prescribed books and periodicals are available in the library in sufficient numbers; 92% students agree with the same. The Librarian is advised to make available the books as per the requirement. More than 97 % alumni are satisfied with the Furnishings, Spaciousness and cleanliness of Classrooms, Laboratories and Library.

About Teachers

Teachers were sincere, punctual and well prepared in delivering lectures and conducting practical; 95% students and alumni are agreeing with the same. More than 89 % students and 97 % alumni reported that modern teaching aids such as YouTube videos (NPTEL lectures etc.), Google Classroom, Power Point Presentations, etc. were used by the teachers. All the teachers are advised to cope up with ICT technology. More than 95% students have agreed that teachers periodically assess students by conducting various modes of assessments. In case of lacunas inassessment the HODs are informed accordingly. More than 95 % students and alumni agreed that teacher's attitude towards the students was friendly, helpful and motivating; assists to participate in co- curricular and extracurricular activities. Almost all students agreed that Curriculum not only helps to obtain employment opportunities but also creates an interest to pursue post graduation/Research.

About College Administration

Majority students responded positively regarding the work of NCC, NSS, Examination, Career Guidance, Competitive Examination and Placement Cells. According to 93 % students well-furnished spacious laboratories and classrooms are available with good internet facility. More than 88% students are satisfied with teacher motivation regarding co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. More than 89 % students and 96 % alumni are satisfied Facilities such as Internet, clean and sufficient drinking water, clean toilets and washroom, well equipped gymkhana.



Q.1 How do you rate your curriculum in relation to the understanding




Q.2 How do you rate the sequence of the courses that you have studied are in sequence to what you have studied in the previous semester?



Q.4 Rate the size of syllabus in terms of the load on the student








From the above graph it is clear that ,there are 63.52% Teachers are Agree to say that Curriculum having current content.

Que3) Programmes outcomes of the syllabi is well defined:




From the above graph it is clear that ,there are 69.41% Teachers are Agree to say that Programmes outcomes of the syllabi is well defined.

Que.4) Curriculum having good academic flexibility:








